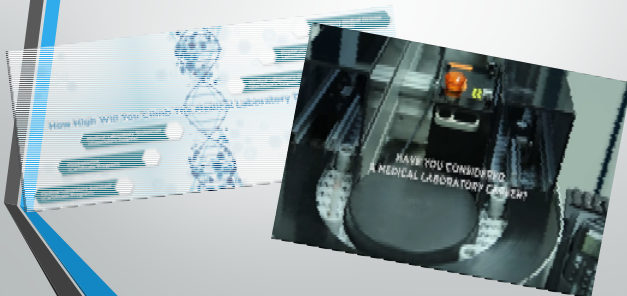
- **E&R Grant** – expansion of criteria to include education topics in 2017
