Clinical Rotation Software: How Is It Used at UTHSC in Memphis?

- Partnership with the Physical Therapy and Occupational Therapy Programs
- Used to "house" all student required documents
 - CBC, Immunization Records (including yearly influenza vaccination), TB Skin Test Results, Health Insurance Coverage, Drug Screen, Respirator Fit Test Document
 - Student Personal Profile, Photo, Contact Information
 - Rotation Handbook for Students
- UTHSC Program Information for Clinical Sites
 - Affiliation Agreements, Program Contact Information, Clinical Faculty Handbook, Liability Insurance Document, Discipline Specific Rotation Guidelines & Checklists, Rotation Evaluation Forms
 - Links to University Health Services (how to handle exposures & emergencies)
