-  **Connect** with other clinical and public health laboratories and exchange lessons learned and best practices.

To establish a sustainable learning community to equip the clinical and public health laboratory workforce with necessary tools, resources, and networks. OneLab's goal is to bridge, train, and sustain a capacity-building community among public health and clinical laboratory professionals and CDC to support rapid, large-scale responses to public health emergencies.
