detection, diagnosis, and treatment of a disease; and

WHEREAS:

Laboratory professionals include pathologists, medical laboratory scientists, histologists, cytotechnologists, microbiologists, medical laboratory technicians, laboratory assistants, phlebotomists, medical secretaries and transcriptionists, and laboratory clerical staff, with many laboratories operating 24 hours a day;

WHEREAS:

Laboratory medicine is an honorable profession vital to the high standards of

health care in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS:

The State of Minnesota honors the tireless dedication, resilience, sacrifice, reliability, determinedness, and flexibility of these professionals in their desire and enduring sense of duty to keep Minnesotans safe and healthy.
