WHEREAS, the efforts of these approximately 300,000 highly-trained and dedicated laboratory professionals and 15,000 board-certified pathologists make an invaluable contribution to quality healthcare and save countless lives each day by providing reliable laboratory test results required for the prevention, detection, diagnosis, and treatment of disease; and

WHEREAS, Medical Laboratory Professionals Week is an excellent opportunity to recognize, appreciate, and acknowledge the dedicated men and women, the unseen heroes, who have a very important role in fighting this global pandemic;
