## Downtown



### > **GEORGIA AQUARIUM**

The Georgia Aquarium is the largest aquarium in the United States and features a variety of exhibits with an emphasis on research and conservation efforts. The aquarium is located just north of Centennial Olympic Park on land donated by The Coca-Cola Company and has been operating since 2005.



### > **WORLD OF COCA-COLA**

The World of Coca-Cola is a museum showcasing the history and flavors of Coca-Cola throughout the decades. The original museum was opened in 1990 before relocating to its current location in 2007 near Centennial Olympic Park and the Georgia Aquarium. Visitors can sample beverages produced by Coca-Cola from across the world and experience unique flavors.



### > **COLLEGE FOOTBALL HALL OF FAME**

Originally founded in 1951, the College Football Hall of Fame was relocated to Atlanta and opened in 2014 where it now serves as a tribute to 977 players, 211 coaches, and countless fans. The attraction features three floors, five themed galleries, and over 50 interactive exhibits for visitors to enjoy and explore.



## > CENTENNIAL OLYMPIC PARK

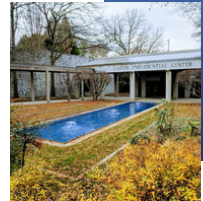


## > JIMMY CARTER PRESIDENTIAL LIBRARY AND MUSEUM
